Freshman Applicants

First-time college degree candidates

- High school transcript(s).
- Two letters of recommendation.
- A graded essay or term paper written in the last year, or a typed, doublespaced essay on the topic depicted in the section below. Include your name and Social Security Number.
- Write your personal story. What makes you different from other applicants? How have your experiences shaped your life? What is your vision for your future?

Transfer Applicants

Previously attended college or post-secondary institutions

- Official transcript(s) from all institutions you have attended.
- Note: Transfer applicants who have completed fewer than 15 college credits must submit an official copy of their high school transcript with graduation certification.

Adult Student Applicants

25 years of age or older at the start of your first term and have not previously attended any college

- Proof of high school graduation or equivalence with graduation date (official transcript or GED certificate).
- Schedule a mandatory interview with a Bloomfield College admission counselor.

Test - Optional Policy

Bloomfield College allows those applying for admission the option of not submitting standardized test scores, except in select circumstances. Students who opt out of submitting SAT/ACT scores will be evaluated on their high school grade point average, curriculum, recommendations, and writing skills, among other achievements.
